ABRAHAM LISTENED TO GOD

BIBLE PASSAGE: Genesis 22:1-19

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Who was Abraham's son? (Isaac)
- What hard thing did God tell Abraham to do? (give his son as an offering)
- How many days did Abraham and Isaac travel to the place where they would do the sacrifice? (3 days)
- What things did Abraham and Isaac take with them to the sacrifice? (wood, fire, knife)
- What did Isaac notice his father had not brought for the sacrifice? (a lamb)
- What did God say to stop Abraham from harming Isaac? ("Do not hurt Isaac.")
- What did God provide instead for the sacrifice? (a ram)
- What blessings did God promise to Abraham for trusting Him? (many children and grandchildren, all people would be blessed by his family)

***Recall the Bible story**

Things you need: "Abraham" coloring pages and crayons

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

Have some fun reinforcing what the Bible taught us today.


***Living it Out/Pray**

Things you need: a piece of candy or other treat, two adults (or older sibling)

Before the game, have one adult (or sibling) hide the treat somewhere. Ask your child which person of the two they will choose to listen and obey. If they choose the person that hid the treat, they will direct them with instructions to find it. If they do not choose that person, they will send them in circles without the reward of finding the treat. Listening to the right person can lead to rewards, and blessings. Abraham listened to God and obeyed His instructions in faith when God tested him. Like Abraham, we are invited to trust God and place our faith in Jesus for saving us from our sins. If we accept His free gift, we will receive the blessing of becoming His child.


