GOD CALLED MOSES BIBLE PASSAGE: Exodus 3 and 4

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- Why did God tell Moses to take off his sandals and not come closer? (Moses was standing on holy ground)
- God heard the cries of His people. What did God want Moses to do? (to go and lead His people out of Egypt)
- What name did God tell Moses to use to explain Who sent Moses? (I AM)
- Name one of the signs God gave Moses to help the people believe that he was sent by God (staff turned into a snake, hand covered with disease, water turned into blood)
- Whom did God send to help Moses? (Moses' brother, Aaron)
- What is prayer? (talking and listening to God)
- Who came to earth to pay for our sin and rescue us? (Jesus)

As your child colors, ask them the discussion questions. Help them answer any questions and see if they have any additional questions.

*Living it Out/Pray


Things you need: jar with lid, a treat

Place the treat in the jar and tighten the lid so that your child cannot open it unassisted. Ask them to open the jar. When they have tried a few times, place your hand on theirs and open the lid together. Explain to them that you were able to succeed in opening the jar because you worked together. God is very strong and there is nothing He cannot do. Just like working together to open the jar, God helps us impossible things He asks us to do, just like He did for Moses. T

Make a list of things that seem impossible and pray about these as a family this week. Remind your children that sometimes we pray for things for a very long time but God always hears our prayers and answers them.


